Summer School FAQs

Is there an age limit?

• There is no age limit, although you must be at least 18 years old.

Do I need to be formally trained in my instrument?

- No, but it's best that you've been playing/singing for more than a year and have a basic ability/aptitude of proficiency in your instrument.
- For the Worship Weekend, you'll need to have experience of being in a worship group.

Do I need to be able to read music?

• No. We will use simple chord charts and/or explain any music notation as we go along.

Do I need to bring anything specific?

• Just the basics you would take on any trip, plus your instrument (drum kits can stay at home).

Where will the course be held?

• Worship, breakout sessions, and study rooms are at UCB's Operations Centre, Westport Road, Burslem, Stoke-on-Trent. ST6 4JF.

Where will I be staying?

• If you opt to pay for on-site accommodation, you will be staying at the UCB Broadcast Centre, Hanchurch Lane, ST4 8RY, which is approximately 7 miles from the Operations Centre where teaching will take place. Please be aware that the Broadcast Centre is a rural location which does not have public transport. However, there is free parking available on both sites. If transport between sites is an issue, please get in touch with Rachel at training@UCB.CO.UK and if we are able to help, we will.
